In their-fervor to see this legislation passed, its supporters have resorted to the sam tactics which were so successfully employed to thwart lynching bills and other civil rights measures for decades. Influential southern congressmen with years of accumulated seniority are exerting every bit of power even if in so doing they violate congressional tradition.

Even those blacks who have reservations about busing recognize the forces who are supporting this legislation as their traditional Thus all blacks and those many enemies. white Americans who are morally committed to inegrated education have stake in the outcome of the drama now being played out in the House, and would do well to let their congressman or Senator know how they feel on this

The passage of a busing curb will not destroy the civil rights movement. Our movement has survived more serious challenges, and lived to flourish despite more disheartening setbacks. But we cannot gain substantial progress -- both in integrating society and securing basic economic dignity--if our attention is perpetually occupied by issues which are amrginal to social progress. This is why we must turn back the assault on integration, no matter what form it takes or how rhetorically cloaked, so that we can proceed beyond symbolic issues to those which touch the essence of an equal and just
