Operation Life has already furnished extensive services to the community by simply opening the doors of the Cove, and furnishing a target upon which the mentally difficient can vent the spleen of their warped minds, for in no other community would these misfits be able to trespass, break and enter, commit malicious, mischief and produce foul graffitti without risking their life. At least two of the illegal activities listed above could result in their being shot to death by security guards. Operation Life will continue to move toward it's constructive goal in the interest of better community services, but remain grateful to the destructive element for making us aware of the types and depts of the Mental Health Programs needed in the Black Community.
