WASHINGTON -- Widows and children of deceased military pensioners would be eligible for government - subsidized benefits under a bill nearing final Senate action, Senator Howard Cannon has announced.

Cannon said the Armed Services Committee, of which he is a member, has passed the bill and that it is expected to reach the Senate floor soon after the Republican Convention re-

"I am hopeful of passage because of its over-whelming support in the House," Cannon said, noting the bill's unopposed House approval. "This bill will give retired military men the same benefits now available to federal civil servants," Cannon said.

Benefits would amount to as much as 55 per cent of a husband's retirement pay. Retirees would pay 2.5 per cent of the first \$3,600 of annual retirement pay and 10 per cent of the amount over \$3,600. The government would
