You are invited to utilize the following services:

**FAMILY PLANNING** - Tuesday and Thursday 5:30 P.M. to 7:30 P.M. Family Planning includes Pap Smears, Pregnancy Testing, Birth Control, Counseling, Diagnosis and Treatment of Venereal Disease.

**IMMUNIZATION** - Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday 2:30 P.M. to 4:30 P.M.

The Immunization Clinic provides shots for diphtheria, smallpox, whooping cough, measles, Tetanus (lock-jaw) and the polio drink. Given by the Public Health Nurse-your child should begin his shots at 2 months but they can be given to anyone under 21 years old.

**FAMILY COUNSELING**-Family Counseling provides professional counseling to those who are experiencing emotional stress.

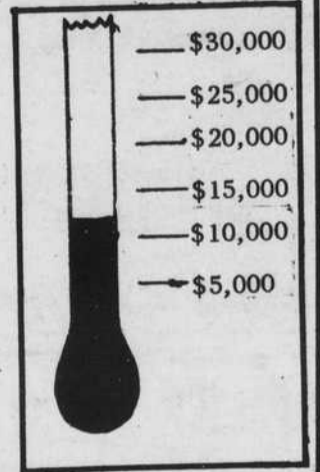
