### Discovering a Black Past



While at Tuskegee Institute,
George Washington Carver
extracted wonderous things from
the Alabama soil. His work
with the peanut and sweet potato
yielded unheard of products
such as ink, cooking oils, peanut
butter, rope and other commodities
beneficial to man.



In 1820, at the age of 15, Maria Becraft

opened a school in Washington, D.C. for girls of her race. Then, in 1831, she turned the school over

to a former student and joined the Sisters of Providence in Baltimore,

which was a teaching order for Black nuns.

Prince Hall, a free Negro, veteran
of the Revolutionary War and
founder of the Negro Masonic order,
spoke out for equal-education
in Boston in 1788. When the
Government of Massachusetts
offered black children only
segregated classrooms, Prince Hall
established a school for black
children in his own home.
