FACTS ABOUT NIC

NIC SAYS - REPORT ACCIDENTS PROMPTLY!

The Nevada Industrial Commission (NIC) requests that reports of injury at work and claims for benefit forms (commonly termed C-2 forms) be mailed to their local office within five (5) days.

The prime reason for this is to protect the injured worker. In addition, prompt reporting can ensure timely correction of unsafe working conditions, according to Safety Supervisor Joe Parrulli, of the NIC'S branch office at 2601 East Sahara Avenue in Las Vegas.

"Late reporting means that an unsafe condition can continue to exist, and the next person to encounter it might be severely injured, or even killed" says Joe. "So prompt reporting of industrial accidents not only protects you, but your workmates too!"
