80 Housing Projects Keep Fred Johnson Busy

FACTS ABOUT NIC

The Nevada Industrial Commission (NIC) can tell you in one word who gains by an industrial accident: NOBODY!

As an injured worker, while you're off from work, you'll receive wage compensation benefits from the NIC. But almost certainly this will be far less money than you earned.

be far less money than you earned. Your family will miss you while you'r in the hospital too. So they lose when an industrial accident takes you off the job.

Your employer loses your services while you'r away from your job. In addition, more claims for workmen's compensation mean higher premiums eventually for your employer. So remember - nobody gains from an in-

Right now, there are about eighty construction projects involving houses throughout the Vegas Valley - and Fred Johnson keeps track of them all. As a Safety Inspector for the Nevada Industrial Commission (NIC) Fred visits all of the projects, to see that there are no hazardous procedures involved.

Fred has the experience it takes to do the job - he's been in the construction industry fourteen years - and got into the safety business through supervising construction work. He was responsible for safety while he was with one of the large construction companies in the area.

Fred has been with the Safety Department of the NIC for fifteen months now, and operates on his own, inspecting all housing construction in Southern Nevada. "The most common safety violations that I find are unsafe ladders, and failure to wear hard hats" says Fred.

Another problem is the construction material that tends to get scattered all over the site. "Boards with nails are a constant hazard. And its very easy to trip over two by four's lying around. But overall, things are a lot better than they used to be in the construction industry" observes Fred.

Eighty construction projects keeps Fred hopping, but he manages to visit them all. So if you're a construction worker, building houses, you can expect to see Fred frequently.

And if he tells you that something is unsafe, with fourteen years on-the-job experience, you'd better believe it - Fred knows what he's talking about!
