Life-Saving Device Requirements

Nevada Department of Fish and Game reports that failure of boat operators to carry sufficient life-saving devices on their motorboats is becoming an ever-increasing problem on southern Nevada waters with many individuals cited each month.


Nevada law requires that there be a U.S. Coast Guard approved life-saving device on board the boat for each passenger.

Not all life-saving devices are approved, and it is not illegal to sell unapproved models. DFG suggests before purchasing a particular type, inspect it for a U.S. Coast Guard approval number that it has been checked and found to be

acceptable. Ski belts and many ski jackets are not approved or sanctioned for legal use on Nevada waters. They may and should be worn while skiing, but there must be an approved life-saving device on board for the person being towed as well as

one for each person in the boat.
