During his eight years in Washington, he served on the staff of Senator Howard Cannon, Democrat-Nevada, the last two years of this employment he served as Legislative Assistant, was the recipient of the Spenser Award (U.S. Army Trophy) for outstanding Leadership, Senior Year Student, co-editor of student freelance publication, THE GRAPEVINE, and was
Tau Kappa Alpha Debate Society member.
In 1965 he took a six month leave from Senator Cannon's staff to work as a Civil Rights

Compliance Officer for the Department of Health Education and Welfare, Office of Education, desegregating school in Texas and Louisiana.

In October 1967, Archie was admitted to practice law in the State of Nevada, the United States District Court of Nevada, and to the practice of law in the United States Supreme Court, May 1972.

Archie, who was voted the Most Outstanding Instructor by students of the Clark County (Las Vegas) Police Academy, received the Black Distinction Award, Las Vegas Branch NAACP in 1971, and the Humanitarian Award, Kappa Alpha Psi Alumni Association for 1973, is active in many fraternal, social and civic groups. He is married to Inez (nee Cobb), they have one son Jason age two.


