### **ELECTRIC RATE** INCREASE

Nevada Power Company has applied to the Nevada Public Service Commission for approval to increase rates in its Las Vegas Division by 2.5 mills per kilowatthour, which will increase revenues by approximately 17%.

Under the application there will be no increase to the first block of the residential and small commercial rates, but otherwise the rate increase would apply to all classes of electric users and all rate blocks. No increase will be applied to minimum bills in any rate class. The added cost to the residential customer is estimated to amount to 13¢ per day on an average.
