city commissioners. This has provided more equal representation for groups who formerly would not be represented. For example, Blacks now have representation on the County Commission and in the legislature thanks to the ward system. I want to make this a reality on the City Commission, too.

Lurie said the only way the Black citizens could really make their will heard was through the ballot box.

"Our right to vote is one of the few rights we have left," Lurie said. "When we go in that polling booth, we tell the world we care about our government. I hope every registered voter votes on June 5th, whether they support me or not. Voting is the way we make our country great."

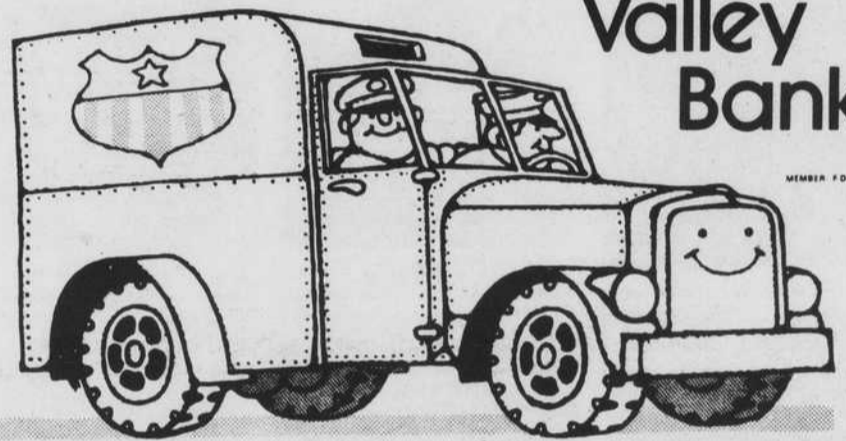
