## Prejudice Must Go

During his tour of the United States in 1912, Abdu'l-Baha in a certain lecture made the statement that "The disease which affects the body politic is absence of love is the cause of disintegration or nonexistence....."

And at another time he said, "Love is the highest law in the great universe of God. Love is the law of order between simple essences whereby they are apportioned and united into compound substances in this world of matter. Love is the essential and magnetic power that organizes the planets and stars which shine in infinite space....Love is the highest honor for all the nations of men....."

In thus tracing the power of this attraction, love as the cohesive and creative force in the universe, it can more readily be understood what was meant by the statement the "The disease which affects the body politic is absence of love and all truism."

It is this cosmic power of love that Baha'U-'llah enjoined in the words "that the bonds of affection and unity between the sons of men should be strengthened; that diversity of religion should cease, and differences of race annulled."
