**Hunter Safety Instruction Required**

"Youngsters under the age of 17 years who do not successfully pass a hunter safety training course will not hunt this fall" warned Charles Crunden, Information Officer for Nevada Department of Fish and Game.

The 1971 Nevada Legislature made hunter safety instructors by DFG have been providing instruction in the Las Vegas area and over the past year have certified numerous youngsters under provisions of the new law.

According to Crunden, however, "Response from young people in southern Nevada has been slow and officials are concerned that a last minute rush in the fall may result in more students than the available instructors can accommodate."

Young people in Southern Nevada who desire hunter safety training should contact Nevada Department of Fish and Game at 4747 W. Vegas Drive, or telephone 385-0285, for assignment to a class in their area. The two dollar fee is paid directly to the instructor when the student reports to his assigned class.

Nevada recognizes and accepts hunter safety certification by the National Rifle Association as well as certificates issued by other State Fish and Game Department. Likewise, most other states recognize hunter safety certification from Nevada.

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
