His interests have extended far beyond the formal education field. For example, he was director of a Red Cross refugee shelter during a Kansas City flood more than 20 years ago. A board member of the American Friends Service Committee in Des Moines, he directed weekend work camps for college students. He was administrator of community relations for the Forest Avenue Baptist Church in Des Moines for seven years and has served on the Mayor's task forces on education and police-community relations.

While a student in Drake University, Des Moines, Harris was sweepstakes winner in the Deletante Art Exhibit and a winner of three Scholastic Art Awards. Some of his work was exhibited in the Library of Congress, Washington, D.C. He has served as NEA Board of Directors liaison with the National Association of Art Education and is a member of NAAE, the Iowa Association of Art Education, and Delta

Phi Delta art fraternity.

Harris has also been a member of the NAACP and Kappa Alpha Psi and a director of the Des Moines chapter of the Boys' Clubs of America.
