## Clark County Community College

Area veterans who plan to attend Clark County Community College during the upcoming fall semester should apply for VA benefits as soon as possible, according to Dr. R. Stephen Nicholson, the college's executive vice president.

Nicholson said early application by veterans will ensure that their benefits will be available

at the time of fall registration.

"A considerable amount of paperwork is required to process VA applications," he said, "but given enough time the problems are minimized." mized."

Veterans planning fall enrollment should contact Vince Ricci, the college's veterans coordinator, at 385-0195 or stop by the college at 737 No. Main.

Ricci said veterans now can apply for the advance educational assistance allowance which is payable at the beginning of the college's enrollment period each year.

This advance payment covers the month or part of a month in which the enrollment period begins, plus the allowance for the next succeeding

"Advance payments are made payable to the veterans, but are mailed to the college for delivery upon registration," Ricci explained.

Except for servicemen enrolled in the predischarge education program, only veterans planning to attend college full-time are eligible for advance payments. For VA benefits, 12 or more credit hours per semester is considered full-time.

More than 500 veterans currently are studying at the community college. Most are enrolled in career programs designed to provide the skills and education necessary to begin new careers in technical and semiprofessional fields.

Career programs of particular interest to veterans include accounting, business, banking and finance, data processing, electronics, fire science, food service, graphic arts, hospitality services, law enforcement, occupational safety and health technology, real estate, and retailing.

As well, the college offers a program of individualized classes, called the "Open College" which may start at any time. Registration for the Open College can be completed Monday through Friday of any week. Classes currently available include developmental English, reading, business machines, typing and study skills.

VA benefits are active eight years from the day of discharge or until May 31, 1974, which-ever is later. Full benefits require full-time enrollment.

Veterans who seek individual tutoring can receive up to \$50 a month for special help in addition to regular education assistance pay-

As well, the college maintains a Tutorial Center offering individualized and programmed learning materials which are self-pacing.

Registration for the fall semester will be August 22-25.
