

HI I'M JOHN

That phrase has been uttered hundreds of times in recent months over local television stations, and has brought fame and recognition to its originator. Now Big John is treated almost like a member of the family when his friendly, smiling face appears on local televison screens.Like many other successful commercials, his has a friendly, warm approach, which apparently appeals to viewers, because it has made his business into one of the most successful in Las Vegas.

"Hi, I'm John" is the catchword of John Maurice Minefee, Modern House Furnture Commercial fame, and winner of 1973 Bummers Award, for the worst commercial in the Las Vegas area. That simple phrase, to Las Vegans and visitors alike, has become a a household phrase, much like "I can't believe I ate the whole thing" and other famous catchy commericals.

It's also meant a fine future for John Minifee. He has been signed by Martin-Akin Productions to star in the new, 1973 verns of Laugh's Inc., first created by Jack Martin in 1943 for the Armed Services.

John arrived in Las Vegas in 1956, and is a 1965 graduate of Rancho High School, after which he enlisted in the Navy and served as a hospital Corpsman. He later joined the Marines and was a medic in Vietnam, where he was selected as the most outstanding corpsman in his division.

Following his tour of duty, he returned to Las Vegas and became a furniture salesman. Two and a half years later, John left the furniture business to sell insurance for Metropolitan Life, becoming, in a few short weeks, the number one salesman in Nevada, and

5th on the West Coast.

A year later, he'd made enough to go into the furniture business for himself and in just two years, he's become the number one furniture dealer in the Las Vegas area. Part of his success, along of course with his sales ability, has been his crazv tele vision commercials. His "Hi, I'm John" commercials then brought him to the attention of Jack Martin, a forty year veteran of stage, screen, and television, who offered him the starring role in his show, Laugh,

Laughs, Inc. was first conceived and produced in 1943 by Jack Martin for the Armed Forces. It was an instantaneous hit, and, after playing for millions of servicemen and women Europe, it remained there, playing before SRO audiences throughout the continent. In 1947, it broke all house records at the El Cortez in Las Vegas, as well as in all the major cities of the US. The 1973 show is entirely new, and is produced by Jack Martin through the facilities of Martin-Akin.

The show also features be a utiful girls and hilarious comedy routines, much in the burlesquemusical comedy vein.
