market. For example, he said, jobs for bank clerks, office machine operators, telephone operators, bookkeepers, stenographers and secretaries will grow in percentages ranging from 15-40 per cent by 1980. But openings for electronic computer operating personnel by the end of the decade will jump 125 per cent, said McCracken.

He emphasized, however, that "stenographers and secretaries are not easily replaced by electronic technology and so will exhibit fairly good rates of growth.

"Another area which will offer excellent job opportunities and is not quickly inflated by technology is sales," McCracken said that statistically, sales people in the insurance and wholesale fields will lead the job growth rate in the overall sales industry through the decade, with openings increasing by almost 30 per cent over 1970.

In another area, McCracken said, "The numbers of air conditioning, heating and refrigeration repairmen in Nevada have tripled between 1960 and 1970." But in view of current energy problems, future trends in these particular fields may be transferred to other and even related areas, the employment chief said. He emphasized that any person possessing the skills required to repair technical equipment will be very valuable to the economy, and energy conservation may even open new areas of employment.

He said several areas where growth should continue at a rapid pace are hospital attendants, waitresses and waiters. "Between 1960 and 1970, the number of hospital attendants increased in this state by 242 per cent and the number of waitresses and waiters by almost 70 per cent."
