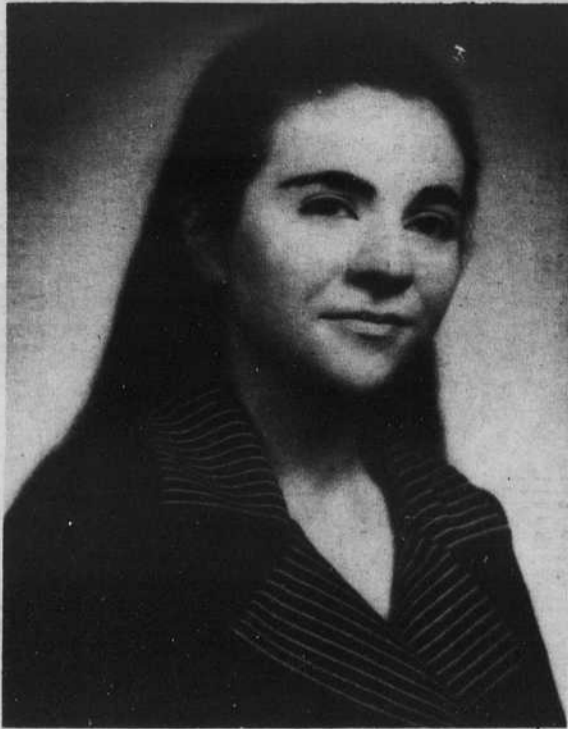
## VA

Eugenia Pintos Ohrenschall, 28, a Clark County practicing attorney, filed Tuesday, for the office of Justice of the Peace for Las Vegas Township.

A graduate of George Washington University and Georgetown University Law Center, Mrs. Ohrenschall, while in the nation's Capitol was employed doing research and case work for United States Congressmen James Kee and John M. Slack, Jr.

Mrs. Ohrenschall also was engaged in doing legal research for the U.S. Senate Subcommittee on Antitrust and Monopoly.

A Nevada resident for five years, she is a member of the Clark County Bar Association, Nevada Bar Association, District of Columbia Bar Association and Maryland State Bar Association.

In 1968 Mrs. Ohrenschall authored "Congress Dumps the Anti-Dumping Code," which was published in the Catholic Law review.

Mrs. Ohrenschall also served as a legal research assistant to the State of Nevada Legislative Counsel, in Carson City.

In 1971 she served as legal research assistant in the office of City Attorney of Las Vegas, and in 1973 was candidate for the position of City Attorney of Las Vegas.

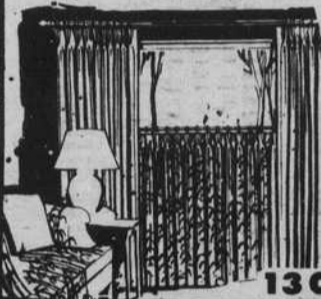
