## COAST GUARD ACADEMY OPENINGS

CARSON CITY--Gov. Mike O'Callaghan today (thur) reminded eligible young Nevadans that the U. S. Coast Guard Academy is now accepting applications for appointment as cadets of the class of 1979.

O'Callaghan said that to qualify for the competition, the academy requires applicants to be unmarried and to have reached their 17th but not 22nd birthday by July 1, 1975. In addition, applicants must be assured of high school graduation by June 30, 1975. Three units each English and mathematics are required.

The governor said appointments to the academy are based solely on annual nationwide competition. No congressional appointments or geographical quotas are involved.

Applicants are selected on the basis of the candidate's high school rank, leadership potential and performance in the College Entrance Examination Board Scholastic Aptitude Test.

O'Callaghan said cadets obtain an excellent undergraduate education at no personal cost, in addition to reasonable living expenses. Graduates of the academy gain a bachelor of science degree and are commissioned ensigns in the U.S. Coast Guard.

The Coast Guard performs search and rescue operations by ship and plane, operates icebreakers for polar expeditions and enforces marine law and merchant marine safety.

Applications for appointments as cadet must be made before December 15, 1974. Applications and additional information may be obtained from the Derector of Admission, U. S. Coast Guard Academy, New London, Conn.
