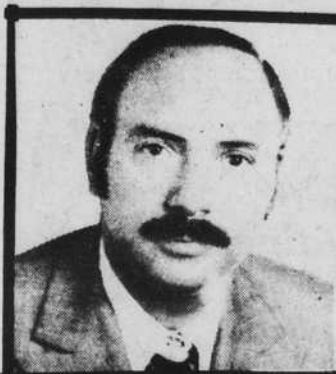

**VA**  
 Q -- I'm interested in applying to the Veterans Administration for a GI home loan after I'm discharged next month. How do I go about this?

A -- It's relatively simple now. Under a recently initiated procedure, VA automatically mails certificates of eligibility to veterans shortly after they are separated from service. After selecting the home you'd like to buy, you should present the certificate to the private lender who agrees to finance the home, then await VA approval of the loan.

## SCIANNA, SAYS

Kerin Rodgers Scianna, 38, of 2117 Houston Drive has filed her candidacy for University of Nevada Regent in District E.

"I believe that I have the insight and understanding that is necessary and that I can make a significant contribution to our university system and our community," she stated.

"The University of Nevada, Las Vegas needs to continue to expand by strengthening its undergraduate programs and by expanding graduate and professional programs. This is one of the fastest growing regions of the United States and our university and community college systems must keep pace with our population increase," Mrs. Scianna explained.

"I particularly want to see the university system in Nevada brought closer to the residents and feel that we have a fundamental responsibility to bring the costs of a University of Nevada education within the reach of all Nevadans who desire it," the non-partisan office seeker stated.

She added, "Our educational system in Nevada must first serve the local residents. One of my goals as a regent will be to find ways to accomplish this and see that UNLV and our community college develop to the fullest potential."

Mrs. Scianna said there is definitely a need for a law school at UNLV but that the cost of starting it must be investigated so that past priorities are not overlooked. She also expressed support for expansion of the UNLV Library.
