

## Library Hosts Blood Screening Program

For the first time in Las Vegas, the personnel and facilities of several major health and community agencies have been coordinated to offer the public free screening program for two serious blood disorders---sickle cell anemia and hypertension.

Hosted by the West Las Vegas Library, the participating organizations include the Nevada Heart Association, the March of Dimes, the District Health Department, the Westside Counsel-ling Center (an outlet of the Nevada Mental Health Center), the Economic Opportunity Board and the Voluntary Action Center.

Throughout the day, on Friday August 30th, at the West Las Vegas Library, the medical and clerical staffs of the participating agencies will conduct free testing and counseling services for all interested persons. Focusing on the two major blood problems of the nation, hypertension and sickle cell anemia, the program aims to identify and assist individuals with such problems in obtaining early and proper medical attention.

For both of the blood problems, a very simple medical test is required. Sickle cell anemia, the hereditary blood disease which affects people of African and Mediterranean descent, requires a small drop of blood for its detection. The very

lastest and most sophisticated equipment, operated by technicians of the Economic Opportunity Board staff, is used to analyze the blood sample. The results of the test will be recorded on a personal wallet-size card for each participant. Counseling, film-strips and brochures helping everyone to understand the disease will be available all day Friday at the Library.

Hypertension, the more common of the two blood disorders, is detected by the very easy blood pressure test. With proper medical analysis and advice, the serious aspects of hypertension can be prevented or controlled for fully participating, healthy futures. Counseling and information for hypertension individuals is an impor-tant part of the all-day screening program.

The screening time will be from 12 noon to 8 p.m., Friday August 30th, at the West Las Vegas Library, 1402 N. "D" Street. All persons are invited to participate; those under 18 years of age must have written permission of a parent guardian for the sickle cell screening test.
