A -- When application is made within one year after release from active duty, dental conditions are presumed to be service connected making them eligible for one time correction.



Nevada Power Report

Nevada Power reported today that the Company's electric energy distribution for the four summer months of June, July, August and September was 1,879 million kilowatt-hours, up 12 % from the summer of 1973. John C. Gibbs, Executive Vice President, said this is attributed to a 4% increase in the number of customers, plus an 8% increased average usage per customer. The increase in customer usage was caused largely by a longer air-conditioning season than usual.

Gibbs said that heavy air conditioner power use was experienced both earlier and later in the summer than has been normal.
