### Bryan Runs For Top Law Post

Senator Richard Bryan, long a champion of minority rights, is ending a vigorous campaign to become Nevada's chief law enforcement officer.

The 37-year-old Democrat, a former two-term Assemblyman and currently a Nevada State Senator, is campaigning on a platform of equal justice.

Bryan is battling Republican Robert List, who has compiled a sorry record of bugging, wiretapping and invasion of privacy during four lackluster years in office.

During the List administration, crime has soared in Nevada, and the state now finds itself in the top five in virtually all categories of crime—a first in rape and burglary.

Bryan has been a champion of conflict of interest legislation, and has fought in the legislature for full financial disclosure for candidates and public officials. He wants a State Ethics Commission to judge matters of conflict of interest, and wants increased consumer representation on the Dairy Commission to insure that we will never again face needless and irresponsible increases in the costs of dairy products.

Bryan's record for minorities is clearly documented.

He is not only a member of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, but was recipient of the NAACP's Justice Award. He is a former member of the Economic Opportunity Board of Clark County, and is past president of the Legal Aid Society. The senator is the former chairman of the Legal Redress Society, and was the first Public Defender in Nevada history.

Bryan was named the "Outstanding Freshman Legislator" during his service in the Assembly, and has continued to fight for the rights of working men and women during his tenure as a State Senator.

"I think my record is in accord with the best interests of all Nevadans," Bryan says. "I have worked for people—people like you and me—who are concerned about making our community a better place
