World heavyweight champion George Foreman's camp Sunday laughed off accusations by Muhammad Ali that the eye cut that led to the postponement of their title fight last month was a fake.

"Ali still talks better than he fights," said Dick Sadler, Foreman's manager. "He can say whatever he pleases as long it helps the gate. I'm going to injure myself if we don't draw well." Sadler made butting motions with his head against a wooden pole.

Ali said Saturday that Foreman really hadn't cut himself Sept. 16, but used a kind of make-up to get the Sept. 25 fight postponed because he was out of shape.

Ali stuck to the charges even though he admitted he hadn't seen the cut and eyewitnesses vouched that the injury was legitimate.

Sports Note: Ali-Foreman fight will be seen "live" from Africa on closed circuit TV around the country on Tuesday, October 29.
