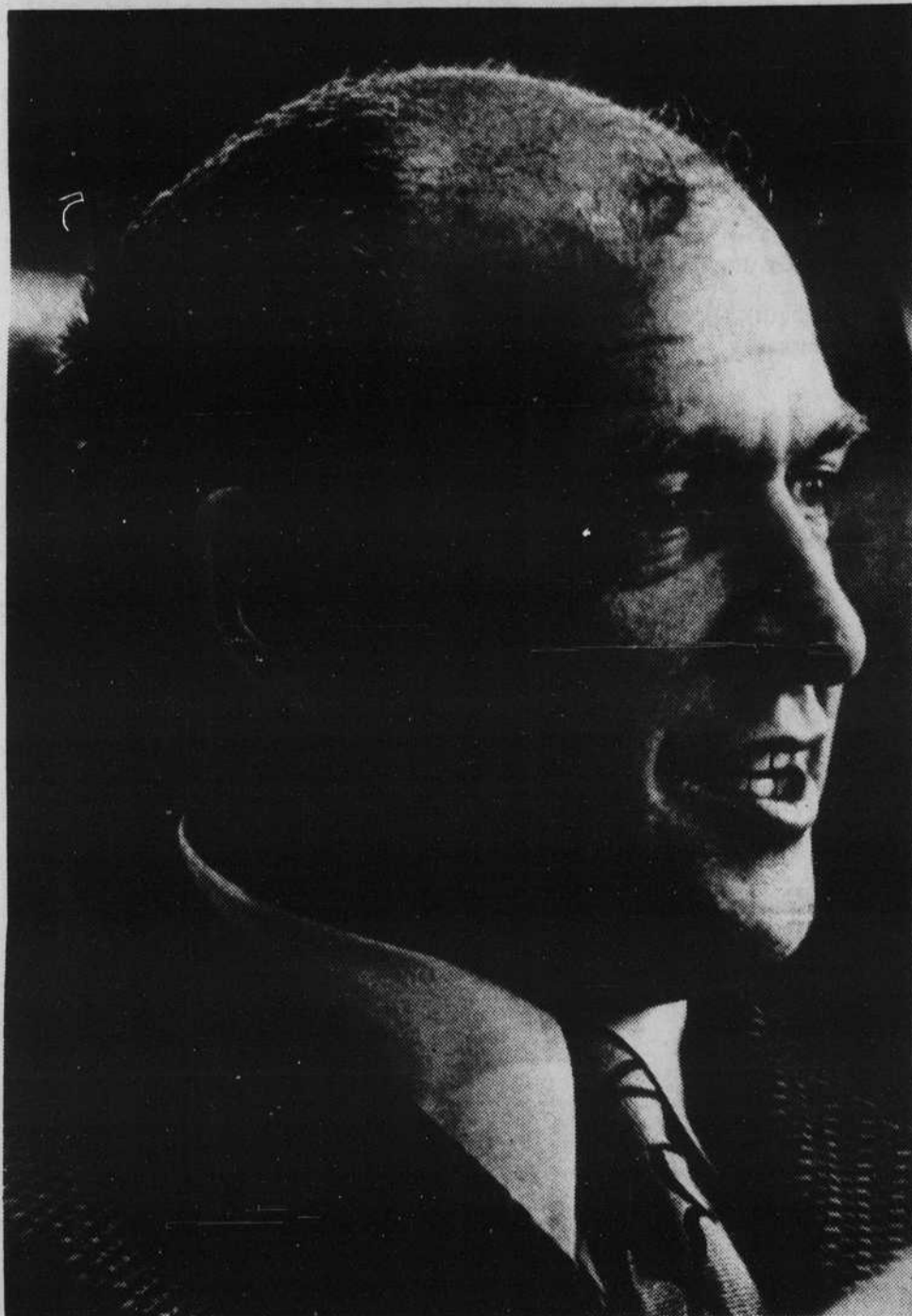

Tax Seminar at UNLV

A federal income tax seminar, designed to help individuals, small business people and the professional persons prepare their income tax returns begins Nov. 12 at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas.

Taught by Internal Revenue Service Agent Ted J. McKelvey, the Continuing Education Course will describe the exemptions allowable and how to itemize deductions.

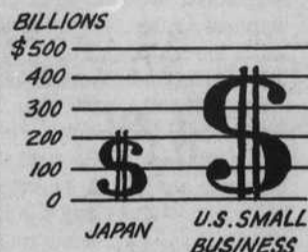
