**Human Services Explored In
 UNLV Professional Course**

The problems of human services administration will be explored by practicing professionals in a 12 week course offered through the Division of Continuing Education at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, beginning Oct. 22. From six to nine guest lecturers from various county and state agencies are expected to participate in this Social Services Administration course, according to Dr. Richard Sutton, associate professor of political science at UNLV and instructor of the course.

Co-sponsored by the UNLV department of social services and the department of political science, the three-credit course will meet from 5:30 to 8:30 p.m. Mondays, through Jan. 21.

"The course will be an opportunity for people in social services to learn and perfect techniques of administration including program management, budgeting new programs, dealing with client-worker and administration relations," Sutton said.

Guest speakers scheduled to participate include Dr. Kenny Guine, superintendent of Clark County school districts; Jim Carmany, director of Juvenile Court Services; Dr. Larry Miller, director of the Southern Nevada Comprehensive Mental Health Center; George Miller, administrator of the Nevada State Welfare Division; Dr. Otto Ravenholt, chief health officer of the Clark County District Health Department; Juanita Blakenship with the Crime Commission and others.
