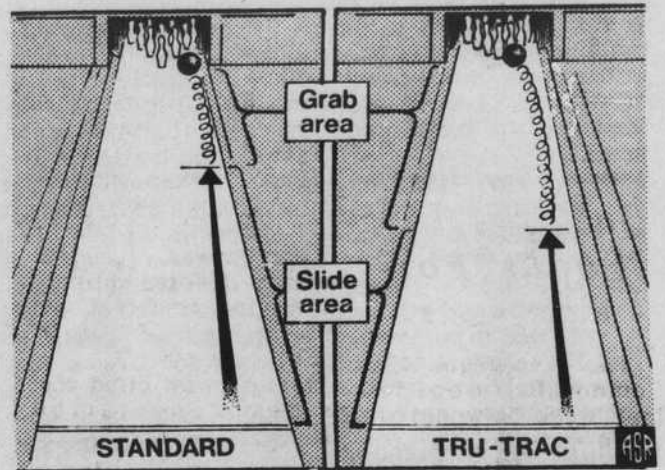
A swimming instructor-trainee, Mrs. Tester volunteered to help in the handicap swim program last year.
