The local office of the Veterans Administration Assistance Service, located at the Federal Courts Building, 300 S. Las Vegas Blvd., has relocated to enlarged facilities at 301 E. Stewart, the Old Main Post Office Building.

The third floor offices will provide additional space to accommodate the need for expanded services and the enlarged staff.

Ray Hines and Milt Lacher, veterans benefits counselors, have been joined recently by Steve Litchock, counseling psychologist, who will provide needed vocational and educational guidance counseling to veterans, disabled veterans and qualified dependents.

"Continuing growth of the veteran population in the Las Vegas area with the resulting need for expanded service for benefits claims, general inquiries and specialized services to disabled veterans and their dependents made this relocation necessary," Herbert Rainwater, VA Regional Office director, Reno, said.

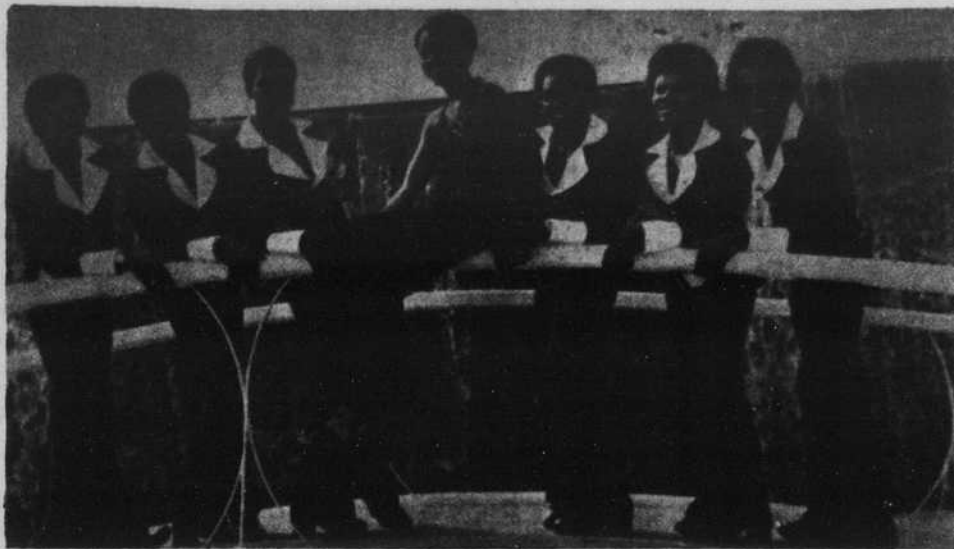
