

EDUCATION HIGH SCHOOL TO COLLEGE FREE SCHOOLING

NEW VO-TECH PROGRAMS

The Southern Nevada Vocational-Technical Center is adding a new career program beginning January 27--a two-year program leading to expertise in turf management and landscaping.

The course will cover all phases of the establishment and maintenance of turf in Southern Nevada climate.

Vo-Tech also has openings for new students in auto mechanics, data processing, and clerical/secretarial science programs. Prospective students must have their applications to the school by Friday, January 24. Classes begin January 27.

Interested youngsters should contact counselors at the high school where they are enrolled now. Appointments will be made for them to discuss Voc-Tech programs at their home school with Dr. Richard Reid, Vocational Placement Advisor.

REGISTRATION

Students should register with the instructor in the classroom during the first class unless pre-registration is indicated. All fees are payable at the time of registration. Fees should be paid by check or money order.

FEEES

There are no fees for students who do not have a high school diploma and have been out of regular day school for one semester. All others will be charged \$30.00 for each one-half credit.

COUNSELING TESTING

Individual counseling with regard to high school completion and vocational courses is available.

The Clark County Evening High School is an official G.E.D. (General Educational Development) test center in Southern Nevada. This test will be administered to qualified persons only. For an application and/or further information, contact the Clark County Evening High School office at 451-1040.

The director of the Clark County School District's high school completion program for adults is interviewing more than 200 people per week as a result of recent publicity covering educational opportunities for persons -who never earned their high

school degree.

About 25 percent of those making inquiries are veterans, who may receive G. I. benefits while attending high school according to Director Norm Christiansen.

Anyone of any age who has been away from

school for one semester or longer who never finished high school may enroll in the program. There is no charge. Classes meet in the evenings at the Southern Nevada Vocational-Technical Center and Western High School.

"This program is

open to all dropouts," according to Christiansen, "regardless of age or where they originally attended school.

"Our objective is to help as many high school dropouts complete their education as we can," he said. "We have room for everyone who qualifies,

since we can always organize more classes as more enrollees come in."
