"Cyclethon '75" - a 25-mile bike ride around Las Vegas, is an activity being conducted by the Nevada Heart Association, to be held on Sunday, February 2, 1975, 8 a.m. until 3 p.m. All Junior High, High School and adult cyclist are invited to pick up entry forms and start soliciting pledges of at least 10¢ per mile from friends, neighbors and businesses. Interested adults who do not ride are asked to cooperate by volunteering to act as marshals, crossing guards, and check-point helpers.

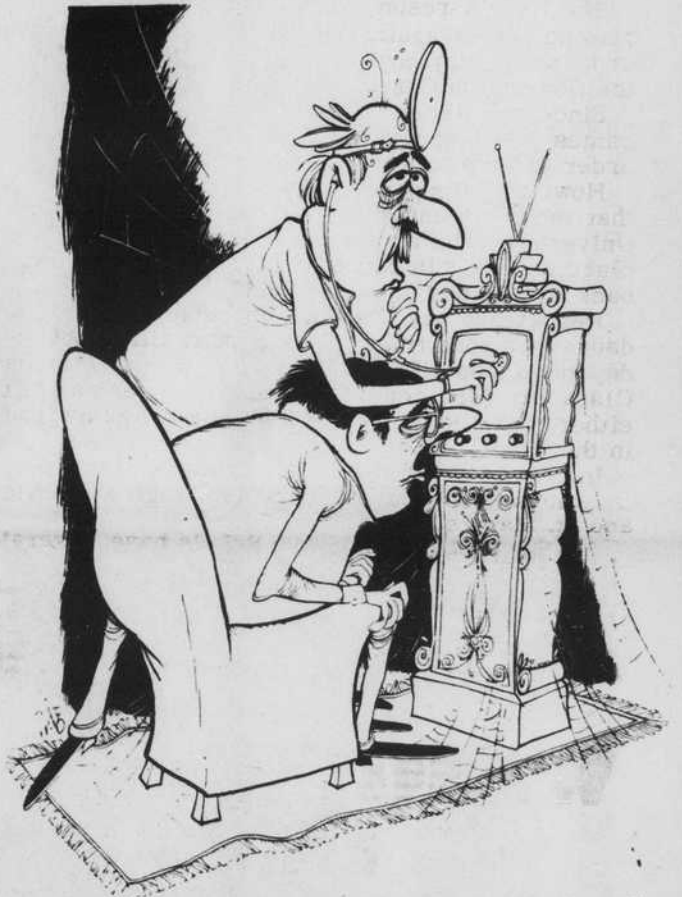
