

Rebels Sister Team on the MOVE

The University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV) Women's Basketball Team, will try to be poor hosts to the Long Beach State 49ers Friday, at 8 P.M., in the UNLV gym, by beating them.

This is an especially important game to the Rebels, because the 49ers handed the UCLA women's basketball team one of its two losses this season, 50-45. But, the UCLA team really embarrassed the Rebels with a 99-33 defeat.

The Rebels will end the three-game home stand Saturday, against the University of Southern California at 8 P.M. in the UNLV gym.

Freshman Jean Major will lead the Rebels into action. She leads the team in scoring and rebounding. Major has started in all 12 games, and has an average just under 17 points a game. She has a rebound average of over 13 points a game. Her 60 per cent free throw shooting puts her in the top position there also.

Major is followed closely by Jackie Alford and Renee Brown. Alford hits about 14 points a game, and Brown has an 11 point average.

The Rebels have outscored its opponents 64 to 59.8 points a game, in its first 12 outings. They have also out jumped their opponents, by out-rebounding their competitors 67.8 to 65.8 rebounds a contest. The Rebels have a first-year record of 7-5.

The club meets on Tuesdays, 3 P.M. to 4 P.M. for youths 12 years and up. Teen Center 6200 Elton.

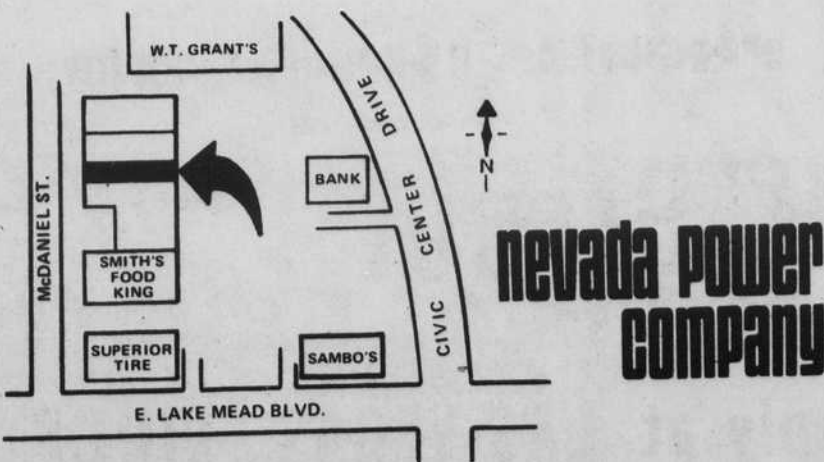
