Elijah Muhammad's son, Wallace, has been named as his successor. Muhammad, who was born on a plantation to former slaves, 77 years ago, and spiritual leader of the Black Muslims for over 40-years, died Tuesday, of a heart ailment.

Muhammad entered Mercy Hospital in Chicago, Illinois, January 29 he had suffered congestive heart failure more than three weeks ago. He had been in critical condition since that time.

#### YEAR SENTENCE EIGHT **IMPOSED**

A North Las Vegas man was sentenced to eight years in prison Monday, for beating a Las Vegas man with a pool cue in a bar.

(hief Judge Paul Goldman meted out the sentence to Michael P. Rainey, 22, of 3715 Shore Ave. who pleaded guilty to one charge of battery with a deadly weapon in exchange for the dismissal of another.

Rainey and two others beat Frank Johnson with pool cue at the Sugar Hill Bar last Sept. 24 when Johnson refused to loan him \$2.

Deputy District Attorney urged Goldman to impose the maximum sentence of 10 years in prison because two men were killed as an indirect result of the beating.
