People planning to retire soon can estimate the amount of their monthly social security check with a free leaflet available at any social security office.

The leaflet—Estimating Your Social Security Retirement Check—explains how much work people need to be eligible for social security benefits and shows how to figure the approximate retirement payment to them and their families.
