

After easing past San Diego, 90-80 Saturday, at Tempe, Arizona, this Thursday, the Rebels play host to tough Arizona State in the NCAA West Basketball semi-finals at Portland, Oregon. On the same afternoon slate, UCLA meets the University of Montana.

In the pre-liminary game at Tempe, Arizona State barely edged out Alabama 97-94. Leading at half-time 57-36, Arizona proved no match for Alabama, after Hollins fouled out with 5.36 remaining in the game to barely win. The Sun Devils lost the ball 13 times in the second half.

The Bruins defeated Michigan 103-91 in overtime at Pullman, Washington. Thr Bruins who have not lost a first round NCAA game since 1963, almost fell at the hands of Michigan, when the Wolverines scored 10 of the last 14 points to knot the score 87-87, at the end of regulation time. UCLA star center Dave Myers, controlled the boards in the overtime period and scored four points, leading the Bruins to their 103-91 win.

In the evenings opener, After trailing 32-26 at half-time, Montana namaged to come from behind and upset Utah State 96-36.


