

Visitors to the beautiful Eden Vale mausoleum complex at 1216 Las Vegas Bldv. North, will now be welcomed to the recently completed Administration Building for Memorial Estate Planning. Construction on the structure which houses 4500 square feet was begun in August 1973 when the rapid growth of Security Counseling Service, Inc., the before need division of Bunker's Eden Vale, indicated the need for larger facilities.


Bunker's Eden Vale Mausoleum and the new Administration Building for Memorial Estate Planning are open to the public daily for visitation.
