HUD Increases assistance

New procedures that will help owners of HUD-subsidized single family homes receive increased subsidy payment and which will also help prevent foreclosure if they cannot make mortgage payments have been put into effect by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

The Office of H. R. Crawford, Assistant Secretary for Housing Management, has issued an instruction requiring lenders to recertify as to "occupancy, employment, income and family composition," homeowners whose mortgages are insured under Section 235, an interest rate subsidy program.

The recertification will be mandatory whenever, because of a reduction in the homeowner's income, he would be entitled to an increase of \$10 per month or more in assistance payments.

If elected mayor of Las Vegas, John C. McCormick would serve for only one term and resign, he said at a press conference last week.

McCormick, who has filed for the office of mayor, says he feels that all public officials should serve for only one term. That way, he says, the "professional politicians" would be eliminated.

"Perpetuation in office leads to corruption," he added, because a politician in office for more than one term has a tendency to build a political machine and to be influenced by pressure groups.

Although a resident of Las Vegas for 11 years, this is McCormick's first campaign for public office here. He once filed to run for city councilman in Las Cruces, N. M., he says, but was unable to campaign because of family and business commitments.

For the past three years he has been employed in public relations for a Strip casino. He is a 21-year Army veteran and a retired captain.

McCormick said he expects to conduct an informative campaign without making any enticing promises to the voters.

He did say, however, that it would be his policy to maintain an "open door" policy if elected mayor. He declared himself in favor of open meetings and open discussion.

McCormick says he will not accept contributions in excess of \$50 from any individual and he will not accept contributions or gifts from firms or companies.

He issued a challenge to other candidates to limit their campaign donations accordingly.
