

HUD Increases assistance

New procedures that will help owners of HUD -subsidized single family homes receive increased subsidy pay-ment and which will also help prevent fore-closure if they cannot make mortgage payments have been put into effect by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

The Office of H. R. Crawford, Assistant Secretary for Housing Management, has issued an instruction requiring lenders to recertify as to "occupancy, employment, income and family composition," homewners whose mortgages are insured under Section 235, an interest rate subsidy program. The recertification

will be mandatory whenever, because of a reduction in the homeowner's income, he would be entitled to an increase of \$10 per month or more in assistance payments.
