LAS VEGAS, NEV.--Following a rousing success two years ago, University of Nebraska former head football coach and current Director of Intercollegiate Athletics, Bob Devaney, will be the guest speaker at the fifth annual UNLV "Thank You" banquet, honoring athletic scholarship donors, July 10 at Caesar's Palace Hotel. The announcement was made today by UNLV Athletic Director Bill Ireland.

Commented Ireland, "Bob was such a tremendous speaker when we had him out here two years ago for the banquet, we just had to bring him back for an encore. He brought the University of Nebraska football program to great heights and he has proven to be a very effective administrator as well."

The July 10 banquet will honor the 1975-76 UNLV athletic scholarship donors for their continued support of the Rebels' 10-sport athletic program. The entertainer for the evening, as previously announced, is Frank Sinatra.

A very humorous speaker, Devaney was given a standing ovation when he spoke at the 1973 "Thank You", dinner.

The word has spread concerning Devaney's speaking ability. On Thursday, he will address the College Sports Information Directors of America at their annual awards dinner at the Shamrock Hilton Hotel in Houston, Texas.

The goal of \$400,000 for this year's drive, directed by the University Rebels Club, is expected to be passed by the time of the banquet, it has been reported by UNLV director of athletic fundraising Dr. Wayne Pearson. Latest released figures show that the drive thus far has netted nearly \$370,000 to help in the growth and development of the UNLV athletic program.
