Black Media Calls On Ford For

SAN FRANCISCO(NNPA) -- Seeking an answer to the constantly rising unemployment rate among Blacks, which exceeds 25 per cent, the National Newspaper Publishers Association has called on President Ford to declare all 10 per cent jobless communities as disaster areas.

And further, urged the President to hold a meeting with a Black deligation to devise programs and policies to meet the critical economic needs of Blacks and other minorities brought on by inflation and unemployment.

These and other demands were expressed in the resolutions unanimously approved by the Black publishers in their 35th Annual Convention recently which both Gov. Edmund G. Brown, Jr., and Lt. Gov. Mervyn Dymally of California addressed California addressed.
