Colangelo, a visitor to Las Vegas during Sobers' career with the Rebels, was pleased to see what he called the "first of an annual event" signed for Las Vegas.

He said "Las Vegas has really developed into a basketball hot-bed since the arrival of Jerry Tarkanian and we feel this is a great opportunity not only for the Suns, but also the Las Vegas basketball fan. With the interest in Rebel basketball, we feel confident a game like this can go over well. Especially with Ricky Sobers in a Phoenix uniform."

Phoenix is considered to be one of the youngest teams in the NBA, yet one of the most promising. In addition to Sobers, two other "first round" rookies who will be on their 1975-76 roster will be 6-9 Alvan Adams from Oklahoma and 6-10 John Shumate from Notre Dame.

Adams and Sobers were both first round picks in 1975 by the Suns, while Shumate was picked in 1974, but was forced to sit out last season with a lung ailment.
