

FREE SOIL TEST DURING JAYCEE FAIR

If you have had problems growing plants, trees, or a garden and you think it may be the fault of your soil, you can have your soil tested free, according to Allen Boettcher, Horticulturist, Cooperative Extension Service.

Bring a cup of soil with you to the booth sponsored by the Cooperative Extension Service, Nevada Nurserymen's Association, and the Federated Garden Clubs. Soil technicians from the University of Nevada, Reno will be on hand to test the soil for you while you are at the fair.

Soil tests will be made from four to ten P.M. August 20-22. Saturday, August 23, they will be done from noon until eight P.M. Sunday, August 24, tests from noon until six P.M.

When taking your soil sample, dig at least 12 inches deep and then slice off enough from the hole to fill a paper cup. Be sure to dig in the problem area you have had trouble with. There is a limit of one free soil sample per person.

The test results will show alkalinity, salt content, and fertility level as related to nitrogen. Experts will be on hand to explain the results of your soil example, concluded Boettcher.

Registration Set For Bridger Jr. High

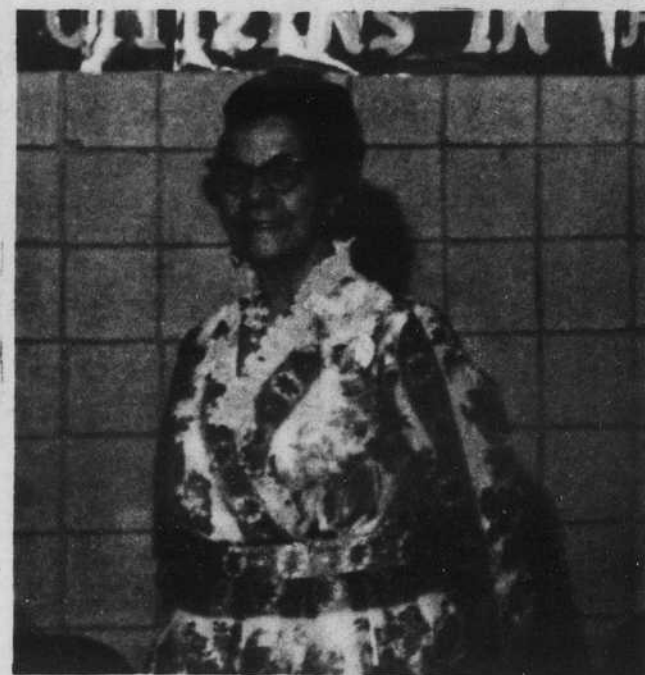
