## Football Hopefuls Flocking To TSU

The waiting is all over. More than 90 football candidates are expected to report to Texas Southern University for the start of fall training Thursday, August 21.

The Tigers will contend with a two-a-day workouts until September 1 at which time the Houston team will revert back to the regular one-a-day program. The morning sessions will get underway at nine and the afternoon periods will start at 3:30.

Twenty three lettermen are returning from the 1974 team that compiled a 6-4-0 record. There will also be 16 returning starters in that number with seven from the offensive unit and

nine from the defensive squad. Included in the returning number is All American quarterback Garland Montgomery. Other top returnees are wingback Don Bolden, split end Ernest Pough, tailback David Harper, cornerback Al Simmons, linebacker Juan Walton and defensive tackles Ollie Barbary and Charles Philyaw.

The players are expected to report to the TSU campus August 18 with team meetings, physical exams and other get acquainted activities scheduled.

Head football coach Rod Paige will be beginning his fifth year as football mentor.




The nucleus for the Alcorn University basketball team which went to the NAIA post-season tournament was William Bell, a 6-2 guard with all the tools.

The most obvious of those is his scoring abilities. Bell averaged 18.2 points per game for Alcorn while contributing floor and team leadership.

He captured enough attention to earn an invitation to play in the Israel Games. The health and physical education major has his sights set for the moment on one more season-this time a championship one. Beyond that he sees pro basketball as a definite goal.

The scouting report on Bell often reads quick, has good eye, accurate outside shot from 15-20 foot range.
