PUBLIC NOTICE

Under the provisions of the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act of 1973, the U.S. Department of Labor has allocated \$1,127,185 to the State of Nevada (Clark County and Balance of State) to supplement CETA Title II (PEP) for these areas within the State. The State of Nevada Employment Security Department will act as Administering Agent for these funds.

(i) As of June 30, 1975, there were 521 participants in the CETA Title II Program for Las Vegas/Clark County and the Balance of State. The additional funds allocated for CETA Title II will be used to sustain participants that are now in the Program. There will be no new hires during Fiscal Year 1976. Of the 521 participants on board, approximately 396 will be terminated during Fiscal Year 1976. Of the 396 terminated, approximately 160 will be placed in unsubsidized employment.

(ii) Of the total population in the area, various significant segments of the population will be served during Fiscal Year 1976. These include Veterans (104 planned to be served), Females (130), Youth (52), 45 years of age or older (52), Minorities (104), Head of Household (391), Primary Wage Earner (469) and Other (52). Included in Other are the handicapped, ex-offenders, persons of limited English-Speaking ability, and Former Manpower Program enrollees.

(iii) The only program activity included in CETA Title II is Public Service Employment.

(iv) Total funds available in the plan are \$1,127,189 in new allocation plus \$591,117 in carry-in funds amounting to \$1,718,306. The distribution of this amount is as follows: Administration \$85,915; Training \$45,154; Services \$2,194; Wages \$1,424,254; and Benefits \$160,789.
