## Jimmy Witherspoon Sings



JIMMY WITHERSPOON

After 28 years in show business, Jimmy Witherspoon doesn't merely sing the blues. He's a big man, and he shouts the blues. He's a heartman, and he cries the blues. He's a tough man who has led a tough life and he has learned to laugh with thunder when the going gets the roughest.

His first appearance was in a concert for the GIs. He sang "Around The Clock" with the Teddy Weatherford Band, and blew the roof off the stadium.

He has toured Europe and the U.S., singing with such back-up musicians as Miles Davis, Gerry Mulligan, Ben Webster, Coleman Hawkins, Count Basie, Woody Herman, John Coltrane and innumerable other world renowned jazz luminaries.

Today, Spoon's music is now music. He brings his entire life to the younger musicians and his new, younger audience, while they in turn freely give their new points of view and ebullient vitality to him. The sharing is perfect.

Now comes Spoon's first album for BlueNote, "Spoonful," and good blues are around again.



## Cal Tjader Live!

The great vibes artist Cal Tjader will be featured at the next concert sponsored by the Las Vegas Jazz Society: 2 p.m. Sunday, February 8, in the Hacienda Hotel Showroom.

Opening the show will be Helen Humes, whose jazz vocal career covers half a century, including "filling Billie Holiday's shoes" in the Count Basie band, the Newport Jazz Festival (1973) and recordings.

According to Monk Montgomery, Jazz Society president, another turnaway situation is expected -- most of the Society's jazz concerts have been total sellouts -- so tickets are going on sale right away.
