King Sr. Visits Israel

The Rev. Martin Luther King, Sr. visited Israel in 1974 with Mrs. King (before her tragic death) and daughter. That visit has been captured in a stirring film called "Martin Luther King, Sr. in Israel - The Dream Lives."

In the film, Rev. King speaks of his commitment to world peace and brotherhood and of his belief that "Jerusalem is the mother country for all the world."

"I could live in Jerusalem - I could preach here," he states in the film.

Rev. King is seen touring the country and at an interdenominational service conducted in the Garden of Gethsemane.

Rev. King also expressed appreciation for Jewish participation in the civil rights struggle in America, and shows reciprocal concern in his visit to Yad Vashem, the memorial to the Jewish victims of the Nazis.

Have you considered enrolling for college classes this fall at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas?

Director of Admissions Robert Stephens issues a reminder that anyone who wishes to enroll for seven credit hours or more in September should complete the necessary admissions forms now.

The admissions process, he said, requires prospective students to fill out an application form, pay a small fee and request transcripts from any previous high school or college attended.

The time for fall admission is drawing to a close, so I encourage anybody who is thinking about earning college credit - whether fresh out of high school or long away from formal studies - to visit the campus as soon as possible," Stephens said.

He said the number of admissions applications is running well above a year ago at this time.

Interpol Collects Tax Data on Americans, IRS Memo Reveals

A 1975 Internal Revenue Service memo to Commissioner Donald Alexander has revealed that Interpol, the controversial private police association, has been used by the IRS to collect information on U.S. tax-payers overseas which is sent to "appropriate districts for handling."

The three-page, partially censored document was obtained under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) by the National Commission on Law Enforcement and Social Justice which has been seeking such links between the two organizations despite the recent denials of Treasury Department officials that Interpol was used for such purposes.

Signed by Assistant Commissioner Harold A. McGuffin, the report was responding to a request from Alexander for an "overview" of IRS "involvement with Interpol."

Attached to the memo was a list of Treasury and IRS personnel who had attended Interpol meetings overseas from 1966 to 1974. Included was John J. Olszewski, Director of IRS Intelligence, who attended Interpol meetings in France (1974) and Austria (1973). Olszewski was also credited in the memo for providing IRS "material" to officials from the Departments of Justice and Customs, also in attendance, who then passed it to foreign police officers at the 1974 Interpol meeting.

McGuffin's reply came two and one-half weeks after Sen. Joseph Montoya (D-NM) announced that he had written Secretary of the Treasury William E. Simon for a "detailed explanation of Interpol and the role of the Treasury Department as its U.S. representative." Montoya stated that he intended to question fully Treasury representatives when they came before the Sub-committee on Treasury Appropriations which he chairs.

Montoya was responding to a 200 page presentation made to him by the NCLE on Interpol's history and work. Montoya told Simon that the NCLE study raised "many serious allegations" about Interpol's access to data on American citizens.
