

Voter Registration Month

Governors of ten southern states have issued Proclamations designating "Voter Registration Month" and urging all unregistered person of voting age to register and vote in this Bicentennial year, according to the nonpartisan Voter Education Project (VEP).

call for full political participation by ten southern governors is an unprecedented expression of leadership which we hope will have a positive effect throught the region," commented John Lewis, executive director of the VEP, the regional organization which intiated the activity. "Our greatest task now lies in the implementation of the Proclamation at the local level."

Although each of the ten Proclamations differ slightly in wording and emphasis, all recognize the need for registration as an affirmation of the principles of democracy celebrated in this Bicentennial year, according to a VEP representative.
