## Quincy Jones Names Winner

## Redd Foxx Makes Movie Debut in MGM's "Norman...Is That You?"

For the past six years Redd Foxx has been known to television audiences throughout the country as the cantankerous, though lovable. Fred Sanford in NBC's "Sanford and Son." But on September 29 Redd's fans will be treated to yet another facet of his talent when he makes his motion picture debut with Pearl Bailey in the Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer comedy, "Norman...Is That you?"

In "Norman" Foxx stars as Ben chambers, an ex-Marine with a problem: his normally mundane, middle class existence in Tucson, Arizona as the owner/operator of a dry cleaning establishment is thrown into unexpected turmoil when his wife runs off to Ensenada, Mexico in Ben's car on a "fling" with Ben's business partner/brother.

Overcome with self-pity and distrought by the loss of his Impala and his wife, Ben travels by bus to the Los Angeles apartment of his son, Norman (played by Michael Warren), hoping to get a little sympathy. What he gets is the revelation that Norman is now living "the gay life" with a young friend, portrayed by Dennis Dugan. How Ben deals with this sudden accumulation of problems serves as the basis for the uprorious thesis of "Norman...Is That You?"

"When people see me in 'Norman' they're going to be surprised," says Redd. "I've shaved off my beard, lost 25 pounds and been raised to a height of six feet, thanks to the MGM wardrobe department. In other words, they definitely will not be seeing Fred Sanford in the movie. But it'll be equally as funny. The story's about change and how one man deals with it. It's something everybody can relate to."

The play was written by Ron Clark and Sam Bobrick in collaboration with George Schlatter, who produced and directed the film. Schlatter managed to coax the legendary Pearl Bailey into playing Redd's wife, creating one of the most exciting film teams in recent years. Ms. Bailey was last at MGM a decade ago when she co-starred in "All The Fine Young Cannibals."

"I Heard That." Over 50,000 contestants phoned, mailed, or presented in person their names for the new group, with Mr. James Washington, Jr. of Detroit, Michigan supplying the winning name.
