

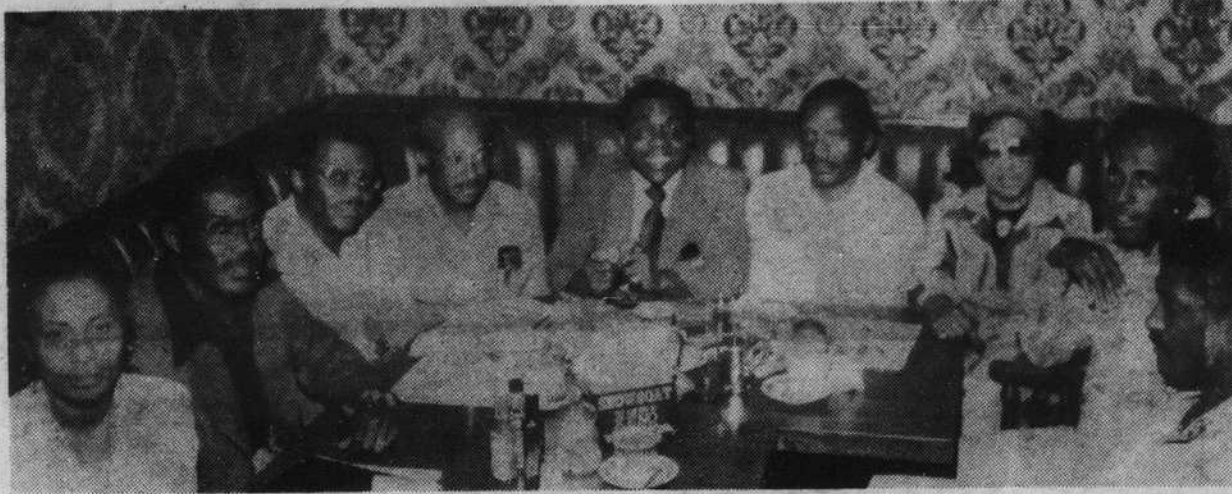

Women, Chicanos and Blacks make up 60% of the total potential work force in Clark County, Nevada. In looking at the employment practices at the Desert Inn Hotel, it appears they must have mis-heard the percentage and thought it was 16% instead of 60%. Of the 149 jobs classified as "Officials and Managers," women, Chicanos and Blacks hold only 24 - or 16.1%.

The real equality of women, Blacks and Chicanos at the Desert Inn is shown in the job category of "Technicians." All three groups were 0% in December, 1972 and 0% in June, 1976.

From December 31, 1972 to June 30, 1976, the percentage of Black males holding jobs classified as "Officials and Managers" dropped from 2.94% to 2.26%. In that same period, the percentage of Black females remained constant at a whopping .6%, with Chicanas at 0%. During April, May and June of this year there were 22 job openings in this category, including 2 Box-men, 2 Casino Shift Bosses, 3 Pit Bosses, and 2 Floormen. Guess who didn't get those jobs?

Women, Blacks and Chicanos do work at the Desert Inn: 87% of all Black females are service workers, 93% of all Chicanos are service workers, and the vast majority of white females are service workers. Similarly, 2/3 of all Black males and a majority of Chicano males are service workers.

White males continue to do well at the Desert Inn. On June 30, 1976, they made up 100% of all technicians and 86% of all officials and managers. Statistics show the Desert Inn discriminates across the board - except and unless you are a WHITE MALE. Blacks, Chicanos and women don't stand a chance. We hate to say it, but can you believe that Lester Maddox did better in Georgia than the Desert Inn is doing in Las Vegas!
