Action By EEOC

Washington, D.C. - During the third quarter of Fiscal Year 1976, the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) filed an additional 71 lawsuits and court settlements while carrying out its role as the Government's chief enforcer of equal employment opportunity in the private sector.

The EEOC's Office of General Counsel reported that by the end of FY 1976, it expects to exceed last year's litigation effort which totaled 318 court-filed actions under the categories of direct suits, interventions, requests for preliminary relief injunctions and court settlements (primarily in the form of consent decrees).

With three months remaining in the current fiscal year, the EEOC had initiated close to 300 actions under the above categories. In FY 1974, the court was 145 for the entire year. Under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of

Under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended in 1972, the EEOC is empowered to initiate civil action in Federal district court when conciliation efforts fail to end job discrimination based on race, color, religion, sex or national origin.

Dance Touring Program

Grant Announced

The Western States Arts Foundation has received \$239,348 from the National Endowment for the Arts to be used as 1/3 funding for this year's Dance Touring Program in the Foundation's ten state region.

The 1976-77 program will involve over 50 communities and 31 professional dance companies in a total of 61 1/2 weeks of performances and residences in Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon Utah, Washington and Wyoming. The total of this year's program amounts to at least \$717,725 in direct fees paid to participating dance companies by community sponsors.

An important development has also occurred in sponsorship of the program over the past three years. While colleges and universities continue to sponsor dance, the sponsorship has broadened its base to include a majority representing community organizations other than institutions of higher learning.

The program was begun in the mid-1960's by the National Endowment for the Arts as a way to link professional dance companies and communities nationwide in in-depth dance experiences. Almost 140 companies are participating in this year's program. The Western States Arts Foundation has coordinated and supplied technical assistance to community sponsors as well as co-sponsored the Dance Touring Program in the west for three years.
