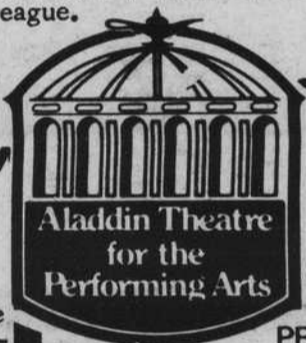

## Programs On Highway Safety

Four consecutive weekly programs on highway safety will air on TV-10 beginning Friday, Sept. 3 at 7:30 p.m. "In the Crash" lets you see a crash the way highway loss reduction advocates see it. Slow motion shots range across a wide selection of recent car crash experiments to let you see how - and why - the metal gets twisted, and the lives broken. On the following Friday, Sept. 10 at 7:30 p.m., "Booby-trap," airs, focusing how needless death and destruction results from roadside booby-traps.

Sept. 17, "Small Cars and Crashes" explains in detail, head-on crash tests conducted between six small, popular "economy" cars and six standard family sedans. "Cars that Crash and Burn" complete the series on Sept. 24 introducing an automotive hazard known for years to government agencies - but unacted on - automobile fuel tanks and systems designed so deficiently they rupture even in moderate speed impacts.
